

CLARIFICATION TEXT ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Nima Iplik Tekstil Ve Gıda San. Tic. Ltd. Sti. (hereinafter referred to as "Nimatex") is the data controller within the scope of the Law on the Protection of Personal Data in respect of all personal data processed through the www.nimatex.com website (hereinafter referred to as the "Site"). All visitors using this website are hereinafter referred to as "User" or "Users". We aim to explain to the site users which of your personal data have been received or are likely to be received electronically while using the site, and to enlighten the Users within the scope of the provisions of both the Protection of Personal Data No. 6698 and the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Your personal data that may be processed by Nimatex are as follows;

- Name, email address
- IP Info
- Location Information
- User Transaction Information

In the event that there are personal data or personal data of special nature that are not listed above by the users, we declare that these data are also subject to the following conditions. However, since there is no absolute guarantee of the confidentiality of personal information transmitted over the Internet, we advise users to take the highest possible precaution when transmitting personal information over the Internet.

METHOD OF COLLECTION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND LEGAL GROUNDS

Your personal data will be processed within the scope of your visit to our website in various forms in certain sections (e.g. CV form) is collected on the basis of the legal reason for the legitimate interest of the Company through cookies in the electronic environment by you filling in the information requested on the screen that appears before you.

PURPOSES OF PROCESSING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

In order to answer your inquiries and provide effective customer service,

- In order to respond to your requests for job applications, etc., to carry out recruitment processes or to communicate with you,
- In order to make statistical evaluation,
- In order to ensure site security,
- To make direct marketing and product promotion through the Site or by the persons with whom the Data Controller cooperates,

TO WHOM YOUR PERSONAL DATA MAY BE TRANSFERRED FOR WHAT PURPOSE

- With the relevant Company Department for the execution of job application processes,
- With suppliers and solution partners for the purpose of carrying out marketing operations,

- With cargo companies,
- With the audit firms and the Company's IT department or information security companies in order to carry out the necessary quality and standard audits,
- With companies that process data on behalf of the Company (IT, site traffic measurement, profiling and segmentation support, support in sales and marketing areas where personal data should be processed),
- In order to fulfill our obligations in accordance with the provisions of the relevant legislation and to audit our commercial activities, with financial consultancy firms, law firms, relevant audit firms,
- May be shared with public institutions and organizations in order to fulfill legal requirements and/or to fulfill the requests of official authorities We declare that Nimatex is not responsible for any damages that may arise due to the use of personal data for the above purposes. Nimatex will not use, disclose, share, sell or make available to third parties your personal data in any case other than the above purpose foreseen.

RIGHT TO ACCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND CORRECTION REQUESTS

Article 11 of the Personal Data Protection Law By contacting us in accordance with the clause, you can contact us about yourself:

- To learn whether personal data is processed or not,
- If their personal data has been processed, to request information about it,
- To learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether they are used in accordance with their purpose,
- To know the third parties to whom personal data are transferred domestically or abroad,
- Requesting the correction of personal data if it is incomplete or incorrectly processed,
- Requesting the deletion or destruction of personal data within the framework of the conditions stipulated in the relevant legislation,
- Requesting that the correction, deletion and destruction procedures carried out in accordance with the relevant legislation be notified to the third parties to whom the personal data are transferred,
- To object to the occurrence of a result against the person himself by analyzing the processed data exclusively by means of automatic systems,
- You have the right to request the compensation of the damage in case the personal data is damaged due to unlawful processing. In order to exercise your above-mentioned rights, your request together with the necessary information identifying you and your explanations of the right you want to use is submitted to Nima İplik Tekstil Ve Gıda San. Tic. Ltd. Şti.;
- After filling out the Personal Data Application and Response Form available at www.nimatex.com address or after preparing a petition in accordance with the procedure, a

wet signed copy of it is sent to Tekstil OSB Mh. 103.Cd. No: 167 Uşak / TURKEY personally by hand, notary public or registered mail with return receipt in writing,

- After filling out the Personal Data Application and Response Form at www.nimatex.com address, you can apply to the data controller by sending it to the.info@nimatex.com address by using your KEP (Registered Electronic Mail) address.

COOKIE POLICY

This Cookie Policy is based on " Nima Iplik Tekstil Ve Gıda San. Tic. Ltd. Sti. (hereinafter referred to as "Nimatex") concerns the WEBSITE operated by and contains explanations regarding the use of cookies. By accepting the information about the cookie policy in the "banner" or "pop up" that you encounter while using the Site, you consent to the processing and use of cookies in the manner specified in this Policy. Who Sends Cookies and How? Cookies are sent by Nimatex and /or third parties (if they provide certain content such as videos or photos on the visited page) and through communication between the browser (such as Google Chrome, Safari, etc.) on your device during your browsing and the servers of the aforementioned entity. What are cookies used for? Cookies are used for many different purposes.

For example, cookies are mostly used for the following purposes:

- Proper functioning of the website (For example, the presence of content such as text, photographs, links in the site in relevant places)
 - To be able to provide a more personalized and more interesting experience for visitors (e.g. to provide services specific to your preferences)
 - Improving and optimizing the website (e.g. making pages with errors or not preferred operational), and
 - Remembering visitors' preferences (for example, information you enter when logging in to our Website, language and other preferences)
 - Keeping visitors' preferences about products (For example, the product added to your cart continues to remain in your cart when the page is refreshed)
 - Keeping track of site navigation movements in a way related to public safety
- ### What Types of Cookies Do You Use?
- Session Cookies refer to temporary cookies that are stored on your devices until you leave the Website.
 - Persistent Cookies Persistent cookies are the types of cookies that remain on the hard disk of your device for a long time and their usage time can vary from a few days to several years.
 - Mandatory Cookies They are mandatory for the website to function properly and for users to benefit from the services and navigation features offered on the site. For example, although not sent by us, social media sharing cookies that are sent to your device by social media networks are mandatory cookies so that you can share news of interest to you on our site or access our accounts on the relevant platform.

- **Functional and Analytical Cookies** They are used for purposes such as remembering your preferences, using the website effectively, optimizing the site to respond to user requests and contain data about how visitors use the site. By their very nature, these types of cookies may contain your personal information. For example, cookies that store your language preference on our site are functional cookies.
- **Cookies for Advertising and Marketing Purposes** are used to identify the products and the like you are interested in in accordance with your explicit consent to the processing, to provide you with a better purchasing experience and include data about which products visitors are interested in.
